

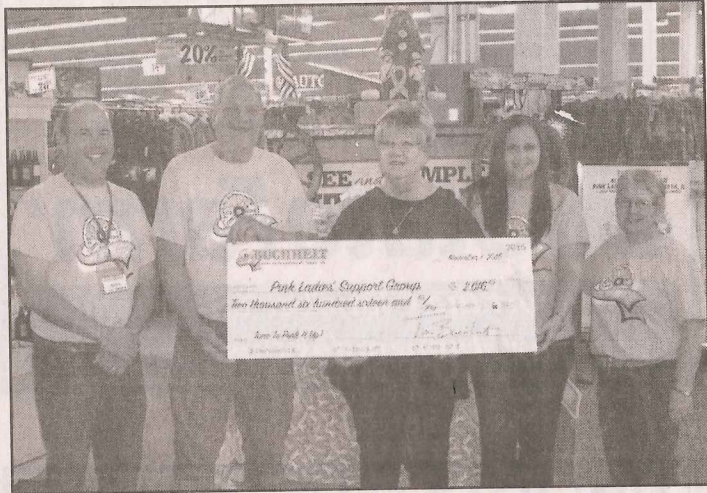
Buchheit of Sparta presented donation to cancer support group

We also plan to donate lap blankets to patients that they can use during treatments."
